STUDENT TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

1. The Assistant Superintendent for Administrative Services shall work collaboratively with the Pupil Transportation Supervisor for the City of Charlottesville to develop and deliver a transportation program for full-time students of Charlottesville City Schools that meets all federal, state and local regulations for student transportation.
2. The Assistant Superintendent shall provide information from the Department of Education regarding the required criteria, training and reporting to the City of Charlottesville transportation department and approve a system of documentation that the requirements are being followed.
3. If the Assistant Superintendent determines that all regulations are not being followed, the Assistant Superintendent shall notify the Superintendent.
4. The Superintendent and/or Assistant Superintendent shall meet with the Pupil Transportation Supervisor to correct any portion of the student transportation system not in compliance. If necessary, a new contract will be written and executed to reflect the changes.
5. The student transportation system shall be available for students to be transported to and from school as well as fieldtrips.
6. The transportation system shall be available to all full-time students of Charlottesville City Schools who reside within the City and attend one the CCS schools or is assigned to another location within the City or nearby locality.
7. A student's eligibility to use the transportation system may be interrupted due to certain disciplinary consequences.
