INNOVATIVE OR EXPERIMENTAL PROJECTS

1. Experimental and innovative programs that are not consistent with accreditation standards or other regulations promulgated by the Virginia Board of Education shall be submitted to the Virginia Board of Education for approval prior to implementation by Charlottesville City Schools.
2. The parent or guardian of a child enrolled or engaged in any research or experimentation program or project which is funded by the United States Department of Education shall be entitled to inspect all instructional materials which will be used in conjunction with such program or project.
3. The procedure for approval of Innovative or Experimental Projects will follow the same process as the Human Research Committee and will be under the direction of the Director of Student Achievement and Program Evaluation.
4. The procedure and necessary forms will be located on the school division website.
5. Any complaints arising under this policy may be submitted under Policies KL or KLB, as appropriate.
